No. MWD 154 MDS 2010, Bangalore, Dated: 15th March, 2011

Whereas, the draft of the Karnataka Minorities Welfare Service (Cadre and Recruitment) Rules, 2010 was published as required by sub-section (2) Section 3 of the Karnataka State Civil Services Act, 1978 (Karnataka Act 14 of 1990) in Notification No. MWD 154 MDS 2010, Dated: 12-01-2011, in part IV-A of the Karnataka Gazette Extra ordinary Dated: 13-01-2011, inviting objections and suggestions from all persons likely to be affected thereby, within thirty days from the date of its publication in the official Gazette.

Whereas, the said Gazette was made available to the public on 13-01-2011.

And whereas, objections and suggestions received in this behalf have been considered by the State Government.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (1) of Section 3 read with Section 8 of the Karnataka State Civil Services Act, 1978 (Karnataka Act 14 of 1990) the Government of Karnataka hereby makes the following Rules, namely:-

RULES

- 1. Title and commencement:-** (1) These rules may be called the Karnataka Minorities Welfare Service (Cadre and Recruitment) Rules, 2010.
- (2) These rules shall come into force from the date of their publication in the official Gazette.

2. **Method of recruitment and minimum qualifications:-** The Karnataka Minorities Welfare Service shall consist of the categories of posts specified in column (2) of the Schedule below, their number of posts, the method of recruitment and the minimum qualifications if any, shall be as specified in the corresponding entries in column (3), (4), (5), (6) and (7) thereof:
