The Directorate of Minority Welfare is functioning from the year 1999-2000 with a vision to enable the minority people to lead a productive life with equal opportunities, ensuring socio-economic justice and equality and also to promote their own literature, culture, peace and harmony.

In order to facilitate and provide financial support the following state Government and Central Government schemes are implemented in the state.

**State Government Schemes**

1. To provide financial assistance for the construction of Shadi Mahals / Community Halls.
2. To provide suitable Hostel Facilities to Minority Students.
3. To construct Hostel Building for Minority Students.
4. Payment of incentives to meritorious minority students.
5. Financial assistance to purchase teaching and learning aids to minority schools.
6. Admission of English minority candidates into Morarji Desai Residential schools.
7. Providing suitable training under Skill Development programmes.
8. Payment of Stipend to ITI/Diploma students of minority communities.
9. Providing Vocational training to minority candidates.
10. Providing Grant-in-aid to minority orphanages.
11. Providing Grant-in-aid to Hostels run by minority organizations.
12. Providing training to Law graduates.
13. Providing Pre-coaching to minority candidates for Competitive exams of UPSC/KPSC and the equal grade posts and also for Common Entrance Test (CET) and Police Recruitment Training.
14. Giving Remedial coaching to 7th, 10th STD Urdu / Kannada medium minority Students.
15. Opening of Working Women Hostels for minorities.
16. National Overseas Scholarship to minority graduates opting to study post graduation in foreign universities.
17. To provide Financial assistance to minority women / divorcees and widows under Bidaai scheme.
18. Establishment of district minority welfare Information Centres in each district.
19. Establishment of Sir Syed Ahamed Khan study and research centre.
20. Skill development training for women in various skills.
21. Opening of Minority schools on the lines of Navodaya Kendriya Vidyalaya schools.

With an objective of Empowerment through Education, Government of India is implementing the following scholarship schemes to minority community candidates the Government of Karnataka with the assistance of Government of India following scholarship schemes are implemented in Karnataka state.

1. Pre-Matric scholarship to minority students of 1st to 10th STD.
2. Post Matric Scholarship to minority students studying from 1st PUC, Diploma, ITI and above level of education.
3. Merit Cum Means Scholarship for those minority students who are studying in professional courses like BE, MBBS, BVSc, and BSC-Nursing etc.
