### **PREAMBLE:-**

The Department of Minority Welfare has been established during the year 1999-2000. Earlier the programmes and schemes relating to minorities were implemented in the Department of Backward Classes. Even after the lapse of 15 years the Annual Income limit prescribed for the families has not being revised. Due to the escalation of the prices of essential commodities, the minorities candidates and students are unable to secure to the benefits extended under various programmes and to get admission in the Hostels. As a result no tangible progress has been achieved in the implementation of various schemes. The Director, Directorate of Minorities read at S.No. (1) above has proposed to increase the limit of Annual Income of minorities families.

After care full examination and in view of the inflation in the prices Government has decided to increase the Annual Income limit of the families of minorities enabling them to secure the benefits extended under various schemes and programmes being implemented for the minorities. Hence the following order:-

### **Government Order No. MWD 21 MDS 2011, Bangalore, Dated:02.08.2014**

In the circumstances explained in the preamble the Annual Income limit of Minorities families is revised with immediate effect for the various schemes and programmes indicated in the Annexure enclosed.

The benefits extended under various Schemes and Programmes of Minority Welfare Department shall be provided to only those beneficiaries who have furnished

the Annual Income Certificates issued by the Competent Authorities. Muslims, Christians, Jains , Buddhists, Sikhs and Parsies religious minority communities are
