

## Eligibility Criteria for 2020-21 NSP and SSP

- Student should belong to Minorities Communities.
- To apply under State Scholarship Portal (SSP), it is mandatory to first apply under National Scholarship Portal (NSP).
- NSP ID is mandatory requirement to apply under State Scholarship Portal (SSP).
- Annual income of the students' Parents/ Guardians from all sources should not exceed
  - ✓ Rs.2 Lakh for **Post Matric Scholarship.**
  - ✓ Rs.2.5 Lakh for **Merit Cum Means Scholarship.**
- Student should belong to Karnataka State.
- 50% of marks in previous final exam/semesters is required for applying scholarship for **Merit-Cum-Means fresh students only.**
- Students of Karnataka domicile studying in other states are also eligible to apply in Karnataka.
- Two siblings from one family only are eligible for scholarship.
