## **PREFACE**

This study was carried out under the Chair of Religious Minorities instituted by the Directorate of Minorities, Government of Karnataka, in the National Law School of India University, Bangalore. Earlier we had carried out a wider study for identifying the gaps in the infrastructure for the human development parameters in four CMC blocks and four TMCs belonging to the Districts of Bidar, Gulbarga, Bijapur and Dharwar of the State. The Directorate of Minorities Welfare suggested that in continuation of the earlier study, another research work may be taken up to identify the gap-filling and non-gap filling projects in the peripheral villages which are adjacent to the blocks and urban settlements covered in the first study. As a follow up to this, we undertook this study and carried out a survey of the villages where the minority population was of the order of 25 per cent and above. Some of the designated researchers visited these villages and conducted interviews using a pre-designed interview schedule, and also organised focussed group discussions to collect the required information. Based on the analysis of such data, the present report has been drafted for use by the Directorate of Minorities Welfare.
